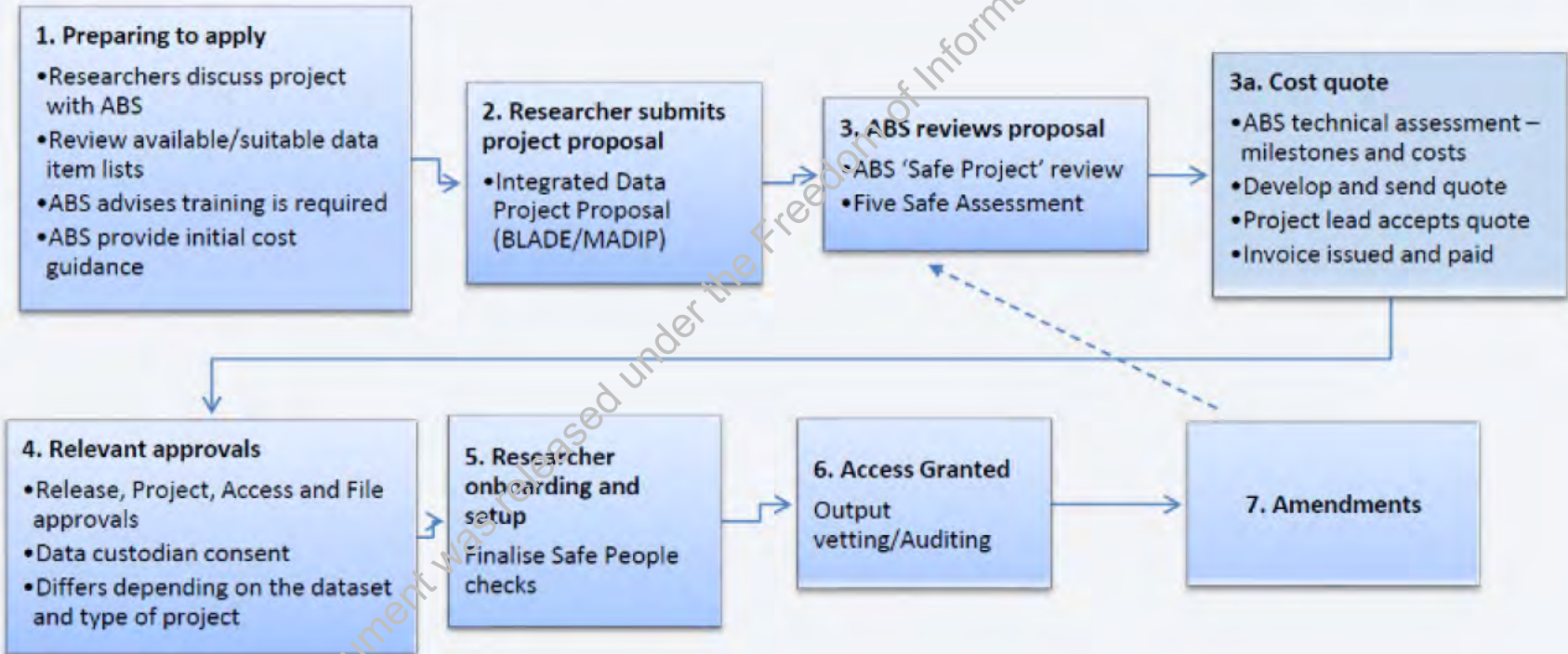

With regards to NNDSS data, I'm not involved in this (it's run through the epis in the National Incident Room). They put out fortnightly or monthly reports on COVID epi here:
